ISI and Membership

All skaters enrolled in our classes become an Individual Member of ISI as part of the annual registration fee paid to us. This membership provides the skaters with a membership card, a subscription to Recreational Ice Skating Magazine, participation in ISI Competitions, ISI Testing, and a supplemental accident insurance policy. Our class curriculum is based on the ISI Recreational Ice Skating Program. Each skating level serves as a building block for the next, so that once skaters master the basic forward and backward skating skills, they can progress to the many other aspects of Ice Skating, including hockey, figure, and speed skating.

All skaters are evaluated on the skating skills taught in classes. These ISI tests are conducted in a fun atmosphere, and help us determine when the skater is ready to learn the next set of skating skills. These tests are nationally registered with the ISI Headquarters.

FIRST DAY OF CLASS

- Please arrive 15-30 minutes prior to the start of class to complete registration paperwork (if not done in advance), obtain your class name-tag and instructor's name. A table will be staffed in the lobby for this purpose.
- Wear warm comfortable clothing (layers are best) that is not restrictive, including gloves or mittens. Helmets are strongly recommended for beginners.
- If you are renting skates from us, you will need to pay \$2 per lesson in the pro shop and take your skate rental ticket to the skate rental counter. A staff member will help you with the correct size and type of skates. We recommend that first time beginners wear figure skates and not hockey skates; figure skates provide more ankle support and overall stability. One pair of thin socks is recommended for the best fit.
- If you have your own skates, let us help determine if they are the correct size and type for you.
- Before class begins, practice walking in your skates in the lobby area.
- Instructors will be introduced in the lobby. Beginner (Pre-Alpha and Tots) level classes will begin off ice. Parents are asked to leave your skater with the instructor and to view the classes from a comfortable distance. This helps your skater stay focused on the lesson and to pay full attention to the instructor.
- Beginner level skaters (Pre-Alpha and Tot classes) are evaluated on the first day of class and grouped according to age and ability level.
- Each week on Tuesday's at 6:30pm and on Saturday's at 1:00pm, there is a 15 minute practice session for class skaters. Instructors are available to answer your questions during this time.
- As your skater progresses thru the class series they are constantly being evaluated by the instructors. If the instructor feels that the skater is ready to move to the next level class, you will be contacted. At the end of the series of classes, all skaters will receive a class recommendation card for enrollment in the next series of lessons.
- Each skater receives passes to public sessions. These passes are non transferable, and are on the skater's class nametag. We encourage skaters to practice the skills they have learned during class in order to progress to the next level of class.
- We reserve the right to cancel classes with no enrollment, and to combine classes with low enrollment.
