

Members of the Lou & Gib Reese Ice Arena Learn to Skate programs are invited to participate in our annual Holiday Show. Additional participants who live in Licking County and skate at the Lou & Gib Reese Ice Arena (individual ISI membership required) are also invited to participate.

Opportunities for participation will vary depending upon the level and age of the skater. The show will feature group numbers as well as solos for those who are in our freestyle or dance class. Group lesson skaters will be performing with their **CURRENT** class level (based on their enrollment in the Fall 2 session). We reserve the right to combine groups according to enrollment.

Currier & Ives

For all who wish to participate in our opening number; we strive for a “turn of the century look”! The costumes should be your own rented, borrowed or purchased long skirt to the ice (floor length), winter jacket, stoll, hat, muff, Fisherman’s sweater, newsboy hat, etc... *There is no additional charge to participate in this number.*

Class Numbers

Skaters will be assigned a group number to participate in for the Holiday show. Groups will be finalized after applications are received. *There is a \$20 charge to participate in each number.*

Soloists, Duets, Ensembles

Skaters who are enrolled in our freestyle or dance classes have the opportunity to do a solo, duet or ensemble for the Holiday Show. Skaters are permitted to sign up for a solo and either a duet or ensemble. *There is a \$15 charge (per skater) to participate in each number.*

Costumes:

- For all of our basic skills skaters, we will be asking them to provide their own black skirt (girls) or black pants (boys). Skaters will be asked to provide their own shirt/sweater. Shirt/sweater colors will be determined once groups are finalized. Female skaters will supply their own in the boot tights for their group number, which can be ordered at a reduced price on the attached registration form.

Rehearsals:

- In order to ensure a quality performance, it is critical that skaters attend their scheduled rehearsals, and each of the performances. A schedule will be distributed on Wednesday, November 22nd--however, please note we have a planned rehearsal on Sunday, November 26th. See last page for general schedule for planning purposes.

Volunteers:

- **We will need your help!** Volunteers are a very important part of the show and there are many areas where we need help: Set Design, Set up/Tear Down, Group Leaders/Room Monitors, etc...
- We will send a request via Sign-Up Genius after Sunday, December 2nd.

Show Details and Logistics:

Seating: All seating for this year's show will be either on-ice table seating, reserved seating on our permanent bleachers, general admission on our on-ice temporary bleachers, or special needs seating area in the lobby. Doors will open 30 minutes prior to the show.

On-Ice Table Seating

We will offer on-ice table seating with refreshments! A carpet will be laid and 10 fold-out chairs will be placed at 8 tables. Cost for on-ice table seating for the show is \$16.00 per person--table of 10 is \$145.00. Deadline to reserve the on-ice table seating is Saturday, December 9th.

Ticket Sales: Ticket sales will begin **Saturday, December 2nd at 9:00am** to the general public for \$6 per ticket. Children ages 3 and younger do not need a ticket if they sit in the lap of a ticket holder.

Show Participants (at the time of the show): Are asked to remain with their group in their respective locker rooms during the show, supervised by two parent volunteers at all times. Due to the size of our locker rooms, we are only able to have two monitors per group for each performance. If space is available, skaters will be permitted to watch parts of the show with their group.

Video Taping & Photography: The show will be professionally videotaped by RES Video, therefore personal videotaping will only be allowed from your seats. Flash photography is not permitted at any time during the show.
