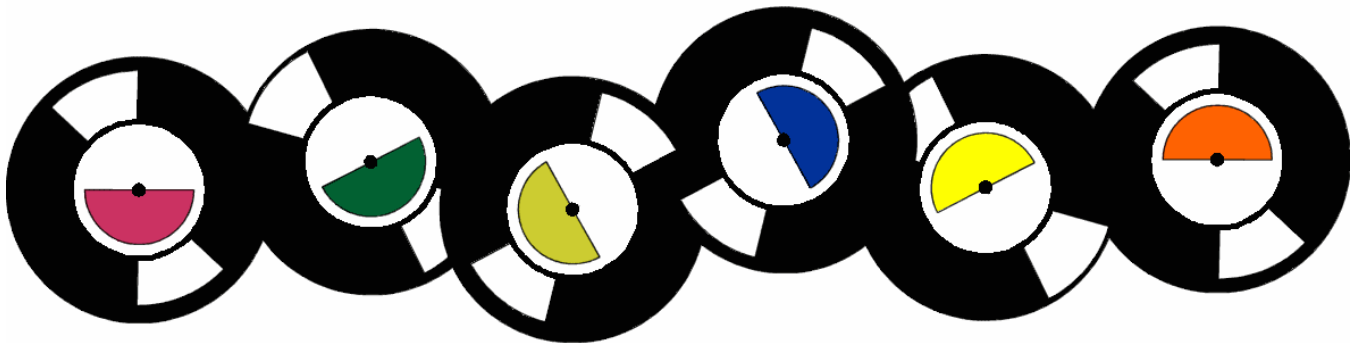

Your skater will not be needed for the entire time block, rather we are sharing dates for scheduling and planning purposes.

A specific rehearsal schedule will be shared after Saturday, April 21st.

Show Performances are on the following dates:

- Friday, May 18th at 7pm
- Saturday, May 19th at 2pm

Members of the Lou & Gib Reese Ice Arena Learn to Skate programs are invited to participate in our 13th annual Ice Show. Additionally, participants who live in Licking, Knox or Perry Counties and skate at the Lou & Gib Reese Ice Arena (Individual ISI Membership Required) are also encouraged to participate.

Opportunities for participation vary depending upon the level and age of the skater. The show will feature group numbers as well as solos for those who have passed the **ISI Freestyle 4 Test by Saturday, April 21st**.

Group lesson skaters will be performing with their **CURRENT** class level (based on their enrollment in the Spring session). We reserve the right to combine groups according to enrollment.

COSTUMES:

- For our basic skills skaters, we will be asking them to provide their own black skirt (girls) or black pants (boys) and we will provide a shirt for their group number. Female skaters will supply their own in the boot tights for their group number, which can be ordered at a reduced price on the attached registration form. Shirts will be distributed during rehearsals as soon as they are purchased.
- For our freestyle skaters, we will be purchasing a costume from a costume supplier. Costumes will be purchased this year from Weissman Costumes. Sizing charts will be on available in the pro shop. The costume fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**, and the costumes are **NOT RETURNABLE**, so order sizes carefully. Female skaters will supply their own in the boot tights for each number, which can be ordered at a reduced price on the attached registration form. Costumes will be distributed during rehearsals, as soon as they arrive.

COST:

- For our basic skills skaters, the cost for participating is \$85, which include a \$20 costume fee, ice time, instruction, and two tickets (on-ice bleachers) to either show. Participation fees help defray the cost of ice rental, costumes, props, and production costs. Substantial donations have been made to the show by the Newark Sport and Event Commission, the Lou & Gib Reese Ice Arena, and LGRIA professionals.
- For our freestyle skaters, the cost for participating is \$135, which includes a \$50 costume fee, ice time, instruction, and two tickets (on-ice bleachers) to either show. Participation fees help defray the cost of ice rental, costumes, props, and production costs. Substantial donations have been made to the show by the Newark Sport and Event Commission, the Lou & Gib Reese Ice Arena, and LGRIA professionals.
- If a skater wishes to participate in more than one group number (i.e. ice-dancing), they will be required to pay the \$50 costume fee.

SOLOISTS:

- Skaters, **who have passed the ISI Freestyle 4 Test by April 21, 2018**, are eligible to skate a solo in the show.
- **Soloists must also participate in either the dance or a freestyle group number.**
- Soloists will be asked to select their music to fit the theme and supply their own costumes.

- Soloists may be asked to perform their program at a date in late April or early May 2018 for the Show Director.

REHEARSALS:

- In order to ensure a quality performance, it is critical that skaters attend their scheduled rehearsals, and each of the performances.
- **Mandatory Dress rehearsal, for all skaters, will be held Tuesday May 15th and Thursday May 17th from 6:00-8:00pm.**

VOLUNTEERS:

- **We will need your help!** Volunteers are a very important part of the show and there are many areas where we need help: Cast Party, Costume Distribution, Publicity, Set Design, Set up/Tear Down, Group Leaders/Room Monitors, Spot Light Operators.
- We will send a request via Sign-Up Genius after Saturday, April 21st.

SHOW DETAILS AND LOGISTICS:

TICKETS AND SEATING: All seating for this year's show will be either reserved seating on our permanent bleachers, general admission on our on-ice temporary bleachers, and special needs seating area in the lobby.

There are 149 permanent bleacher seats, 108 on-ice temporary bleacher seats, and 20 special needs lobby seats available for each show. ***All participants will receive two on-ice bleacher seat tickets to either show.*** Doors will open 30 minutes prior to the show.

TICKET DISTRIBUTION & SALES: Ticket sales will begin **Tuesday, May 1st at 9:00am** to the general public for \$6 per ticket. Children ages 3 and younger do not need a ticket if they sit in the lap of a ticket holder.

SHOW PARTICIPANTS (Day of Performance): Are asked to remain with their group in their respective locker rooms during the show, supervised by two parent volunteers at all times. Due to the size of our locker rooms, we are only able to have two monitors per group for each performance. If space is available, skaters will be permitted to watch parts of the show with their group.

CAST PARTY: Join us for a special reception Friday evening after the show honoring the cast and our graduating senior!
